

CELEBRATIONS MADE EXTRAORDINARY AT SENTUL PAVILION



Located in Sentul West and just 5km from the Kuala Lumpur city centre, Sentul Pavilion embodies the form of a stylish glasshouse, a striking structure that is impossible to miss amidst a dominating green landscape.

The modern aesthetic of this versatile space paired with towering palisades draws the lush greenery of Sentul Park inside and brings a sense of light and space to every event.




The spectacular glasshouse and surroundings create an extraordinary experience for all events and celebrations.

Tall glass walls create a visual impact that is equally impressive from the perspective of its shimmering exterior façade, as well as from the inside looking out. Its towering palisades blur the lines between indoor and outdoor space, inviting both the green landscape and the brilliant sky to be the highlight of any event held within this 10,000sq ft facility.

The design takes the elegant sloped roof to new levels, which soars to a height of 18 metres at The Hall and descends to double-volume height at The Foyer. Standing at the entrance, the sensation is one of mesmerising natural beauty and stylistic design, brought together in a luxurious setup.


The Foyer, designed to be a separate and intimate pocket within the glasshouse, was carved out as a pre-function venue or as an exclusive event space in itself which accommodates up to 100 guests. The glass-encased foyer offers a spectacular view of its landscaped surroundings, which can be enjoyed at ground level or from an elevated perch of a mezzanine level. Featuring a grand, bronze-touched marble staircase that spirals up to the upper floor, this fully carpeted section also boasts its own bar area at ground level, making it ideal for private functions or corporate get-togethers.




A cosy passageway leads into the expansive setting of The Hall, which immediately captivates with a breath-taking vista of the enveloping landscaped beauty of the park. Framed by towering glass palisades, guests here will be able to take in surrounding meadows, lush tree tops and the natural hue of the sky while engaging in the spirit of an occasion.

With a capacity to house 300 guests, The Hall is carpeted in shades of azure and is designed with column-free spaciousness to entertain and inform a diverse range of audiences.

The expanse of The Hall and its spectacular setting provides full flexibility to transform the versatile space into an idyllic venue for events of any desired design, from wedding receptions and milestone events to brand showcases or corporate annual dinners.



The ambience of The Hall, enveloped by its surrounding view of lush greenery, invites a magical touch of class into the interior atmosphere, making grand events here a truly memorable experience.


RECLAIMING NATURE'S PLACE IN OUR SPACE




A design philosophy that resonates with our own outlook is the creation of biophilic environments, which will be further enhanced in our up-and-coming developments. The future will only see a greater embrace of this ideology, as we expand on our efforts to renew the relationship between nature and the built environment.

Biophilic design is an ideology that focuses on methodologies to reconnect people with the natural environment, through direct and indirect influences. Beyond the aesthetic and health benefits that come with an immersible natural environment, it is a sustainable concept with natural cooling and ventilation factors that bring economic benefits.

The principle of reconnection with nature that biophilic design provides refers to tangible interactions with natural features. Light, air and water are natural elements that are made an integral part of the functionable space so that they constantly influence your environment. This brings a sense of calm, comfort and appeal to your daily routine, which in turn impacts your overall psychological state.



Inviting natural light and beauty into every space is just one of the many ways to reinvent the way we engage with the work environment as the bond with nature remains unbroken even when we are indoors.



Interior spaces within Sentul Works are seamlessly connected with the outdoors and provide variable experience internally through creation of a double-volume atrium, bridges and fenestrations.

In this design methodology, plants are not simply restricted to specific corners for aesthetics and ambience, but allowed to cascade off walls and thrive in all corners of any interior space. This way, they are not an addition to any given space, rather an important part of its design. Plants bring the richness of natural character to the personality of a building, while increasing physical health, improving productivity and reducing stress.


Life itself is an important part of this component, not just with open public spaces and parks that invite a vibrant congregation of people, but also through the addition of aquariums, trees that invite birds and gardens that nurture a micro biosystem. Studies have shown that apart from promoting interest, this type of interaction increases mental stimulation, enhancing the human capacity for happiness, as well as provides restorative and healing effects.

Indirect experiences are an accompanying element of a biophilic environment, where the influence of nature is evident throughout the building via visual cues. Widely defined, this could be the use of natural materials in the structural design of the building, or even a depiction of nature-centric images that adorn walls.

Another important characteristic of biophilic design is the provision of transitional space. This element aims to connect interior spaces with the outdoors, or create comfort by providing access from one space to another environment through the use of porches, decks, atriums, doors, bridges, fenestrations, and foyers. This creates variable experiences within the same vicinity, which helps break the daily monotony of your environment.

Constantly seeking to enrich the way we interact with our environment, YTL Land has brought the biophilic philosophy to new frontiers in Malaysia, seeking to revolutionise not only residential developments but also the office and commercial experience. To this end, we will continue to grow our outlook on bringing its positive impact to the spaces we create in the future.

Perceptive of the fact that today's urbanites typically spend one-third of their life at work, YTL Land is paying much-needed attention to enhancing the environment of work spaces, and by adopting the biophilic philosophy to create a benchmark work and live experience.

Bringing this philosophy to life is Sentul Works in Sentul West, a repurposed century-old colonial building which ticks all the boxes when it comes to providing a true biophilic experience. A pioneer of biophilic design, Stephen Kellert cited the underlying principle to be "a celebration and a show of respect for nature, and the provision of an enriching urban environment that is multi-sensory". Sentul Works captures that spirit.

Situated within a private park, the new-age historical building offers a direct experience with nature, as the surrounding landscape offers a tangible relationship with greenery, water, clean air and an abundance of natural life. This influence is transferred into interior spaces, as sunlight filters in through large windows and vegetation is a consistent part of the ambience, either via an ever-present panoramic view of the enveloping park or the greenery cascading down interior walls, bringing life to many nooks and corners. An elevated landscaped outdoor deck also offers a quick escape to nature, providing an ideal spot to de-stress and seek inspiration amidst swaying leaves in the breeze.

Nature also indirectly influences the interior space at Sentul Works, informing the choice of natural materials that combine with its prevalent industrial feel to create its unique modern-rustic feel. Earth tones are also a distinct feature, bringing a quiet sophistication to the designer's palette to complement its natural backdrop.




Nature is never too far away at Sentul Works. Landscaped grounds within a private park provide an ideal escape for weary souls or inspiration for creative minds.

'Into the Wild' was designed as a travelling cultural event, inviting guests to step into the universe of Cartier's most recognised and beloved icon, La Panthère de Cartier—from the origins of her magnificence, to the woman who inspired it, as well as the savoir-faire that brought her to life.


Sentul Depot's Workshop 3 was transformed into an atelier, taking guests on an immersive experience through time from when the panther first showed its spots on a woman's watch in 1914 to its evolution in present day.

The two-week immersive installation found its synergy in the rich historical setting of Sentul Depot which was once the finest integrated railway engineering hub in the 1900s. Today, the sprawling space has been regenerated as part of YTL Land & Development Berhad's masterplan for Sentul West.

The rejuvenated landscape has evolved into a must-visit lifestyle destination in Kuala Lumpur, providing the perfect background for the design inspiration behind Cartier's exciting exposition and delivering a truly experiential event for aficionados.
